**Exit Cincinnati-Dayton Road south, left onto Lesourdesville-West Chester Road, left on Barrett.**



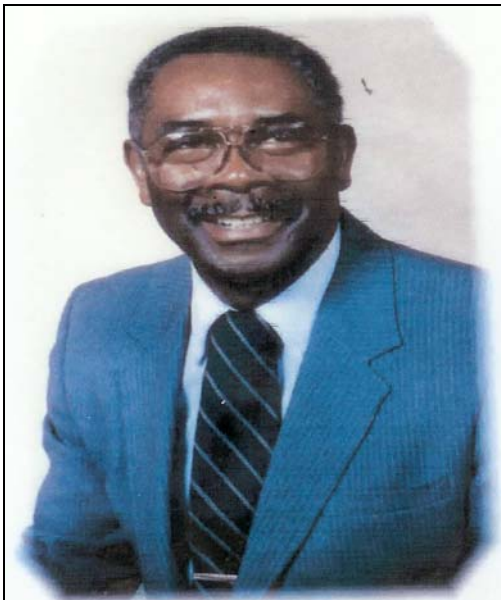


# PRAYER.....Our connection to God

- Ask God to help one person whom you find it hard to like.

- Ask God for help in achieving your personal goals.
- Ask That God will tell you the most important thing you need to do to see His will today.
- End by listening intently for 3 minutes to what God may say to you.
